Sarcoma Left Shoulder Challenged by Post Radiation Treatments

- Patient 78-year-old male
- Recurrent sarcoma to left shoulder, resection of sarcoma (x2) flap reconstruction dehisced and necrosis
- Cardiac patient - pacemaker prevented pectoral flap
- Radiation treatment x2
